Tip corner – traveling with T1D

Traveling with T1D can be stressful and have unique challenges, but with careful planning and preparation, you can enjoy your adventure! Here are some tips to consider:

- Pack more than you need – at least twice the amount of supplies.
- Have a prescription available for insulin in case you run out.
- Tell airport security that you have T1D, are wearing a CGM or insulin pump, and are carrying supplies.
- Bring a T1D snack and supplies bag with you on the plane in case your luggage gets lost.
- Do not pack insulin in a checked baggage.
- Carry a doctor's note and wear a medical ID tag.

Discuss your travel plans with your healthcare team.

They can give you advice on insulin doses and meal plans to adjust to time zone changes and different activity levels.
